

CONFIDENCE

This one word is one of the determining factors of whether you and your horse are successful or not. I had a customer in here this weekend that has a really nice barrel horse but was having a few challenges that she wanted to work on. In this particular case, like in most cases, it simply came down to the rider asking for a response from her horse in a way her horse understood. Once she figured out HOW to ask for that response you could just see the confidence in her face and her body just bloom and grow, she immediately started to relax and that was a result of her confidence growing as well. When you start feeling good about your horse you also start feeling good about yourself and then that communication gap between you and your horse starts to disappear. If we lack trust and respect from our horses there is no way they will have confidence in us or vice versa. When you develop trust and respect with your horse you also gain confidence. When you have confidence in your horse they will have confidence in you. If you are in a frustrated state of mind there is a 100% chance that your horse is in a frustrated state of mind. It's not a lack of communication, it's a lack of understanding between horse and rider and what responses are being asked. This applies to all disciplines. Our horses are a reflection of what we know, and how well we communicate with them and help them understand what we are asking. It's just that simple. You need to be able to ask for a response and get the same response every time from your horse. That's what's called a foundation. When a horse understands what is being asked of them they start to develop confidence in the rider/trainer. Always remember that we are constantly training our horse's minds to think and help them understand what responses we are asking for. Correct repetitions create good habits. Hope this helps! Have a great month of Training and God Bless!

As a principal Jana is once again charging ahead, leading her staff to pursue excellence by continually promoting what is best for the kids.

Jana is constantly going above and beyond not only for the teachers she works alongside, but for the students as well.
